

Among this author's many previous publications are *Hidden Hierarchies: The Professions and Government* and *Toward Holistic History—the Odyssey of an Interdisciplinary Historian*. She attended law school at the University of California at Berkeley and spent eight years as a research associate at that university's Center for the Study of Law and Society. Her Ph.D. is from Harvard. In addition to years of full-time university teaching, she has worked for local and state governments and traveled extensively. She is currently writing a book about the globalization of the American automotive industry.
